



## **PRIVACY NOTICE FOR EVENT PARTICIPATION**

Open Fiber S.p.A., with registered office in Viale dell’Innovazione 1 – 20126 Milan, Italy, VAT No. 09320630966, as the Data Controller (hereinafter the “Controller” or the “Company”), informs you, pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (also “General Data Protection Regulation” or “GDPR”), that your personal data and those of the minor of whom you are the parent (hereinafter “Data”) may be processed according to the methods and purposes set out below.

### **PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING**

The Data you provide for participation in the event will be processed (for the definition of ‘processing’, see Article 4(2) GDPR) for the following purposes:

- Organizational and logistical management of the event (e.g., registration, reception, sending logistical information);
- Documentation and communication of the event through photos and videos, which may be published on internal channels (intranet, newsletters) and external channels (institutional website, corporate social media).

The legal basis for purpose 1 is the Controller’s legitimate interest in ensuring your participation in the event.

For purpose 2, the legal basis is your explicit consent, which you may withdraw at any time. Providing consent for image and video processing is optional and refusal will not affect participation in the event.

You also declare that you have nothing to claim from the Company, its assignees or successors regarding the use or dissemination of your image.

### **PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED**

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The personal data processed are:

- identification and contact data (name, surname, address, phone number, email);
- any additional information you voluntarily provide, including special categories of data, necessary to participate in the event;
- photographs and audiovisual recordings taken during the event.

### **DATA RETENTION PERIOD**

The provided data will be retained as follows:

- personal data, additional voluntarily provided information, and identification documents: up to 6 months after the end of the event;
- photos and videos published on the website and corporate social channels: up to 5 years from the date of the event, for historical archiving purposes.

### **DATA PROCESSING METHODS**

Data will be processed using paper and electronic tools and appropriate security measures to ensure confidentiality and protection against unauthorized access or loss, in compliance with GDPR principles (Chapters II and IV). Data may be processed by internal or external personnel specifically authorized and bound by confidentiality obligations.

Photos and videos may be published on LinkedIn, Instagram, Facebook, X, and on the openfiber.it website.

### **DATA DISCLOSURE**

Data may be processed by third-party companies acting as Data Processors. Access within the Company will be granted only to personnel requiring it based on their roles. Without your explicit consent (Art. 6(b)(c) GDPR), the Controller may disclose Data to supervisory bodies, judicial authorities, or other entities for whom communication is legally mandatory.

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## **NATURE OF DATA PROVISION**

Providing Data is mandatory for purposes described under purpose 1. Failure to provide such Data will make it impossible to proceed with processing.

## **DATA TRANSFER ABROAD**

Data will not be transferred outside the EU. Should the need arise, the Controller may relocate servers to non-EU countries, ensuring compliance with Articles 44 et seq. GDPR and adopting appropriate safeguards.

## **DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER**

The Company, based in Viale dell'Innovazione 1 – 20126 Milan, VAT No. 09320630966, has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) under Article 37 GDPR, who can be contacted at: [dpo.of@openfiber.it](mailto:dpo.of@openfiber.it).

## **DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS**

As a Data Subject, you may exercise the rights under the GDPR, including:

1. the right of access (Art. 15), obtaining confirmation of processing and accessing relevant information (purposes, categories, recipients, retention, rights, complaints, data source, automated decision-making, safeguards for transfers);
2. other rights (Arts. 16–21): rectification, erasure, restriction, portability, objection.

The Company will respond within one month, extendable based on complexity or number of requests, providing justification. Responses may be written or electronic.

You may lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority.
